Dry Eye



Dry eye is a common condition whereby a person does not have enough quality tears to lubricate and nourish the eye.

Causes of dry eye

- Dry, dusty & windy conditions
- Insufficient tears
- Excessive use of computers and handphones
- Underlying systemic diseases
- Aging
- Certain medications (antihistamines, birth control pills etc)

Signs and symptoms

- Red and itchy eyes
- Foreign body sensation

Treatment

- Artificial tears

Conjunctivitis (Red eye)



Conjunctivitis is the swelling of the conjunctiva, a thin membrane that covers the white part of the eye and inner eyelids.

Causes of conjunctivitis

- Bacterial or viral infections
- Exposure to allergens, dust and smoke

Signs and symptoms

- Red and itchy eyes
- Excessive tearing
- Eye discharge and lid crusting

Treatment

- Eyedrops to treat the infection or allergy

Pterygium



Pterygium is the painless growth of a clear, thin tissue that lines the white part of the eye. It is generally harmless.

Cause of Pterygium

- Excessive sun exposure

Signs and symptoms

- Foreign body sensation
- Increased astigmatism in advanced cases

Treatment

- Surgical removal if necessary

Keratoconus



Keratoconus is a condition where the cornea thins, weakens and becomes abnormally cone-shaped. It can cause vision deterioration if untreated.

Who is at risk?

- Family history
- High astigmatism
- Chronic eye allergies and eye rubbing

Signs and symptoms

- Distorted vision
- Sensitive to bright lights
- Double vision in one eye

Treatments

- Rigid contact lenses
- Surgical treatment

Glaucoma



It is a condition characterized by progressive loss of vision due to optic nerve damage. It is broadly classified into:

Open angle glaucoma and **Close angle glaucoma**.

Cause of glaucoma

Increase of internal eye pressure due to various reasons.

Signs and symptoms

Open angle glaucoma

- No symptoms

Close angle glaucoma

- Nausea, red & painful eyes
- Seeing rainbows around lights

Treatments

- Various eyedrops
- Lasers
- Surgical treatments

AMD (Age-related Macular Degeneration)



AMD occurs when the delicate cells of the central retina (macular) gets damaged and stop working. There are 2 types of AMD: **Dry AMD** (more common) and **Wet AMD** (more serious)

Causes of AMD

- Aging
- Smoking
- Excessive sun exposure

Signs and symptoms

- Blurring and distortion of central vision
- Sensitive to bright lights
- Poor vision in dim places

Treatments

- Dry AMD** : To monitor and intravitreal injections
- Wet AMD** : Laser treatment and intravitreal injections

Retinal Detachment



Retinal Detachment is a condition where the retina separates from the wall of the eye. It is a medical emergency.

Causes of retinal detachment

- Short-sighted eyes are at higher risk
- Eye injury

Signs and symptoms

- Seeing floaters
- Seeing light flashes
- Seeing a black curtain over the field of vision

Treatment

- Surgical treatment

Diabetic Retinopathy



Diabetic retinopathy is a common complication of diabetes, which causes damage to the cells and blood vessels at the back of the eye (retina).

Cause of Diabetic Retinopathy

The elevated blood glucose levels (hyperglycemia) in a patient with diabetes

Signs and symptoms

- Distortion of shapes
- Reduced central vision
- Severe loss of vision
- Having a dark or empty spot in the center of your vision

Treatment

- Laser treatment and intravitreal injections
